- First and foremost, know that we appreciate your help.
- No matter how small the task seems, the work that you do here is important to our operation. By treating each assigned task with purpose and diligence, you will be greatly increasing the efficiency of the Food Bank, and enabling us to better serve those in need.
- For insurance and safety purposes, children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times. We require at least 1 adult for every 6 volunteers under age 18.
- Prison inmates from a local camp are here to help us each day. Although volunteers will not be working directly with these men, they may be in the vicinity. They are well supervised at all times.
- Volunteers will be provided with cold bottled water.
- Please – dress modestly. No shorts or halter-tops. Volunteers must wear close-toed shoes to protect themselves while in the warehouse. Volunteers who arrive in violation of this dress code will be asked to reschedule their shift.
- Please follow the directions of the staff who demonstrate how to do each task. It may not seem the easiest or quickest way to you, but our methods are based on many years of experience
